A few details. Doors will open to the public at 6:00pm. All questions for candidates must be submitted each evening in writing and will be selected and asked by the moderator. Meet and Greet with candidates will start at 6:30pm. Uncontested candidates for District 6, Commonwealth Attorney, Sheriff, Commissioner of Revenue and Lord Fairfax Soil and Water Conservation Director are invited to join us for the Meet and Greet. Forum will start promptly at 7:00pm and will be facilitated by an impartial, volunteer moderator.

Details for Candidate Forums:

For District 2, we will begin the forum at 7:00pm with short remarks from the Board of Supervisor Candidate and then follow with introductions and question and answer session with the School Board Candidates.

For District 3, we will begin the forum at 7:00pm like above with remarks from the School Board Candidate and then follow with introductions and question and answer session for Board of Supervisor Candidates. We will then take a short break, and start back with Candidates for County Treasurer.

General Assembly, we will begin the forum at 7:00pm with introductions and question and answer session with the State Senate Candidates, and then take a short break, and start back with Candidates for State Delegate.

It is our intent that this forum will be a civil, nonpartisan discussion of the issues and we hope an informative event for county voters. For additional details, see the enclosed candidate forum guidelines.
